

Mitok is a 8-year old Siberian Husky who found his way to our home through the South Florida Husky Recue Organization 6 years ago. He was diagnosed with lymphoma, which is very treatable with chemo but highly aggressive and can end his life in a month if it's not treated, with treatment, he has an 80% chance of remission. He is very healthy and never been sick and the vet says he has a great chance!

His first two years of his life were spent in and out of shelters, once badly beaten, once covered in ticks and fleas to where he desperately tried to pick up his head and on death row to look at the volunteers who eventually saved him. My son Zach and I drove 6 hours to meet him at a ranch where there were many huskies for adoption...like 35! They brought him out to us and Zach, then 12 yrs old, knelt down and said hello. Mitok was very shy and untrusting. After looking at Zach for a moment, Mitok came forward and put his head on Zach's shoulder...I cried...he chose us! The rescue couldn't get him to take treats...however as we drove home with our new baby, Zach offered Mitok a fry and the rest is history...needless to say "treat" is his favorite word now!

I'm a single Mom struggling to make it and Mitok has brought such joy to our lives, I know he was a fighter without a family, and now that he's got a family to love him through this, we just need some financial help to pay for chemo. I've already spent almost \$2,000 and drained my savings account, this is my last hope. We greatly appreciate anything you can do to help us, and Mitok appreciates it as well.
